History/Yearbook



Until the mid-1960's, the first Philo meeting of the year in September was a breakfast held at local venues. In 1945 the traditional breakfast was held at the Loveland Power Plant, otherwise known as Viestenz-Smith Mountain Park. In 1976 and again in 2013, floods devastated the park. The Civilian Conservation Corps structure, where the Philo ladies would have held their breakfast in 1945, was completely washed away. The Park has had to adapt and change significantly since its opening in 1926.

This year Philo has again adapted to the continuing effects of COVID-19. On Wednesday, September 15, Philo members met at the First Baptist Church for our first general meeting held in person since March 2020. Our usual meeting place at Trinity Lutheran Church is currently unavailable due to restrictions on capacity (no more than 20). As a consequence, our meeting place and time have changed. Though the setting was different, members were excited to see one another and move forward with Philo business.
