

PHILO GIRLS TO DISTRIBUTE YULE BASKETS TO 120 NEEDEY FAMILIES

Once again the Philo girls will take the role of Santa Claus for the unfortunate of Loveland.

The Philo club today is gilling 120 Christmas baskets which they will distribute to needy men, women and children tonight and Tuesday afternoon. This evening they will leave Christmas baskets at the homes of needy aged persons as they make their rounds of the city singing Christmas carols and tomorrow afternoon will visit the needy boys and girls leaving them food, candy and toys.

The 45 Philo girls have been working for weeks on this Christmas charity work and have spent nearly \$200 to make it possible. The \$150 they received from the Rialto theater for their charity fund has all been used and \$25 in addition and the girls used \$30 from their own fund for Thanksgiving baskets.

The baskets which they will distribute to needy tonight and tomorrow will contain fresh roast, potatoes, beans, tomatoes, cereal, butter, rice, soap, apples, oranges, prunes, candy and toys.

Trucks are being furnished by Harry Mattison, the Bonnell Chevrolet company and the City of Loveland; \$150 from the Rialto theater; the Sorosis club donated candy; the Rainbow Girls stockings which they filled with candy; the Boy Scouts, Campfire Girls and Young Business Builders gathered and fixed the toys, and many persons donated money and other articles.
