The General Federation of Women's Clubs is planning to add a fleet of 50 bombers to our nation's Air Force, each bomber to bear the name of a State Federation of Women's Clubs. The Colorado Federation has set for it's goal \$300,000 which will finance a heavy bomber. The Philomathean Club will have a booth in bond headquarters or you may leave your name at the bank and ask that credit be given the Philo Club.

The Philo Club was organized in 1919 and is made up of business women, teachers and housewives. The club has been very active in charity work and in all city projects and is deserving of your cooperation in this project.

Bond Drive Is On With Sec. Five Leading in City

Loveland volunteer bond workers and the city investors are off to an early start. Workers were out in force and results began to pour into bond headquarters in the First National bank building. This office is also a war bond booth for the Philo club, whose members are keeping the office open every afternoon. If you wish to give the Philo club credit for the sale of your bond, mention it at the time of purchase.

Bomb shells have arrived for the signatures of bond buyers, who can sign the bomb any time at headquarters. After the drive these shells will be shipped to the ammunition dump for loading and then will be delivered uninvited to Tojo. You will want to be there in name if not in person. One of the shells will be at the high school for the drive there.
