2012 Golf Tournament News

Most of you know by now that the 2011 Golf Tournament was a great success, netting over \$17,000 to fund the Philo Scholarship Program. Since the first golf tournament 6 years ago, over \$85,000 has been awarded in need-based scholarships. What a great accomplishment!

Our goal for 2012 is to make \$20,000 which will easily push the total scholarship amount to over \$100,000 to help local Loveland/Berthoud residents help themselves.

The golf tournament has evolved to become the primary fund raiser of Philo and in order to continue the success, each member's help is needed.

Here is how:

1. Secure Sponsors – This is the key way money is made by the event. Gerry Henderson heads up the sponsorship subcommittee and will provide information about the sponsorship levels, benefits, required forms, talking points, and lists of organizations to contact. We all deal with businesses and service providers each day. If every member would obtain one sponsorship – the results would be phenomenal!



2. <u>Prize Donations</u> – The prize drawings are one of the biggest attractions for the golfers and lunch participants. Last year we had 67 great prizes including 5 valued at \$500.00 each. Johna Cabrera heads up this

subcommittee and will have contact information, talking points and ideas on how to collect the prize donations OR you may prefer to join forces with a Philo sister and create a prize basket with a specific theme. Johna will have guidelines and theme suggestions or help you create your own.



3. Spread the Word – Survey data from past participants show that "word of mouth" has been the best marketing for this event. Talk up the event, encourage golfers to register, explain the goals of the fundraiser, believe in the cause (scholarships), and boast the benefits of fun and camaraderie with women friends - all at one of the most beautiful golf courses in Colorado!



4. Mark Your Calendars – Friday, July 13, 2012 – Mariana Butte Golf Course. The Golf Committee is counting on you to participate. The scholarship recipients are counting on you to support this great community outreach service.
