

PHILO GENERAL MEETING MINUTES

Feb. 9, 2016

WELCOME

President Nita Starr called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. And thanked our hostesses for the evening: Marthann Dahlen, Denise Rhoads, and Juanita Cisneros.

BOARD MEMBER REPORTS

The minutes from our meeting of Jan. 12, 2016 were motioned for approval by Kay Robinson and seconded by Miki Roth. Minutes were approved.

EARLY CHILDHOOD
