There were a total of 202 families and elderly that received food baskets in 2015. Three churches, six organizations/groups/clubs and 27

non-Philo community members helped deliver baskets or contributed financially. As in the past Philo had wonderful participation by our



members. 101 Philo women participated by delivering at least one basket or making a financial contribution. The Christmas Food Baskets committee, with the help of several additional Philo women, delivered 25 baskets. In addition, our new, community minded, fall fundraising event, "Dine Out With Heart" provided further funding used to purchase gift cards for Philo members to use if they so desired to supplement the baskets they made and delivered. I'm going to close with some pictures from the Dine Out With Heart committee. They sent these to the Board and I thought everyone would enjoy seeing them.


