### From the Philo Scrapbooks

Editor's note: We are running the February and March Scrapbook articles in this newsletter. One article was inadvertently omitted last month.

February 2015

Philo members in the past celebrated Valentine's Day by entertaining their husbands. Three memorable evenings were described in the *Reporter-Herald*.

In 1947, "A delightful Valentine party was given by the members of Philo club, Tuesday evening, for their husbands. Stewart Case, who has charge of recreation at Colorado A & M college, arranged a varied and enjoyable program of games, contests, and square dances in which all participated with zest."

In 1962, Philo members entertained their husbands at a Valentine dinner at the Wayside Inn in Berthoud. About 100 people attended. The Loveland High School Band performed and students demonstrated current dances. *[quite different from square dancing, I am sure]* 

In 1964, "Hootenany at Philo University," featured a smorgasbord for the husbands. "The program opened with a performance by the Cockroaches, Loveland's answer to the Beatles. The trio, composed of Grant Ford, Fred Anderson, and John Lussenhop, performed with uke'ele accompaniment."

In the 1969-70 yearbook, the program for February 10 was called "The Dating Game." The description reads, "Wives date their husbands in a bold new version of the dating game."

I am not certain what to infer from the fact that "The Dating Game" was the last reference to a Philo Husbands Night in our scrapbooks!

#### March 2015

In the early years of Philo, one of the two March meetings was Guest Night. Entertainment often featured high school choruses and theater groups as well as local dance studios. At other times club members themselves would perform.

In 1943 a style show was presented at Guest Night, "All This and Fashion, Too." Again in 1947 fashions from the Duff store were modeled by club members on Guest Night. The next year was the first of Philo's Style Show, an annual event until 1982.

There will be more about the style shows next month.

#### WEB CONNECTION - COMMITTEE SIGN UP

<u>Please Note:</u> One of Philo's membership requirements is that every active member serves on a minimum of one committee.

If you were a co-chair of a committee you will need to move to the chair position of that committee provided the chair vacates that position. This allows for a trained person in the chair position.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Go on line to Philo's "Members' Only" page.

(If you have never accessed the "Members' Only" page, please contact Trudy Eckhardt 667-1455 or Peggy Pellizzari 669-8744 for assistance.)

2. Click on the "SIGNUP" icon to access the Philo Committee Signup.

(Signup icon is located following Yearbook information.)

3. The new page you see will be titled "Philo Committee Signup".

On this page you will see the words: "Please select your name" with a box underneath.

- 4. Click on the down arrow, (located on the right side of the box), and all Philo Members names will appear in an alphabetized list.
- 5. Scroll down to your name.
- 6. Click on your name.
- 7. Your name now appears written in the box. (If a different name other than your name appears in the box then reselect the correct name. Your name is your password for you to drop or add your name to a committee. Once your correct name appears, then proceed to step 8.)
- 8. Click on the box that says "Next".

(The new page will say "Welcome \_\_(with your name)\_\_\_, and shows all committees with members.)

a. Please add and/or delete your name from committee memberships, by clicking on the checkboxes. (These checkboxes are the outlined boxes located in the "drop me" or "add me" columns where changes can be made.

b. You will need to "drop" your name from committees that you served on in 2014 -2015 and do not wish to serve on for 2015-2016. This will provide additional openings for other members to select. You then can "drop" your name from a committee by clicking on the outlined box in the "drop me" column. This change will not be visible until Step #9 when you "update" your changes.

c. You then can "add" your name to a different committee as long as there is an opening by clicking on the outlined box in the "add me" column.) This change will not be visible until Step #9 when you "update" your changes.

d. If an opening is not currently available you can sign up for another committee and wait to see if there is an opening for your desired committee later.

e. Philo's membership only requires that you sign up for one committee, however you may sign up for more committees if you wish and there is room.

9. After dropping /and or adding your name to committees scroll all the way to the bottom of the page and click the "update" button. This will update your selections and show the list of committees again. You can then verify that your name is removed or added to a committee and that what you selected is what you want.

# YOUR CHANGES WILL NOT BE SAVED UNTIL YOU CLICK ON THE "UPDATE" BUTTON.

#### 10. If you need to make additional changes, then repeat step 9.

- 11. If you are satisfied with your changes, then click on the "NEXT" BUTTON TO FINALIZE YOUR SELECTION.
- 12. A new page will say the number of committees you dropped and the number of committees that you added. Then it will read "Any previous changes have been saved. Thank you for updating your Philo committee participation ."

You have completed the Philo committee signup for 2015-2016.

Close the signup window/tab and close the Members Only window/tab.

CONGRATULATIONS! YOU HAVE SUCCESSFULLY SIGNED UP FOR 2015-2016 PHILO COMMITTEES.

NOTE: You can re-do a sign up as many times as you like during the sign up period.
