#### Fashion show plans moving ahead nicely--

An annual event for over twenty-five years, the show is a forecast of spring and summer fashions modeled by Loveland ladies. The clothing and shoes are furnished by Loveland merchants. Eleven shops will show this year and each shop will have a minimum of two outfits.

Tickets for the fashion show are one dollar and are available at the door the night of the show or you may purchase them from any Philo member. ### PHILO COMMITTEE SIGNUP

<u>Please Note:</u> One of Philo's Membership requirements requires every active member to serve on a minimum of one committee. You may serve on more.

We have pre-loaded all of the new Chair and Co-chair positions that we are aware of. If you see a Chair or Co-chair position open when you are signing up, please consider filling one of those positions!

INSTRUCTIONS: (please read the entire instruction before executing)

• Go on line to Philo's "Members' Only" page.

(If you have never accessed the "Members Only" page, please contact Peggy Pellizzari at 669-8744 for assistance.



• Click on the "SIGNUP" icon to access the Philo Committee Signup.

(Signup icon is located following Yearbook information On the Members Only page.) The new page you see will be titled "Philo Committee Signup".

- On this page you will see the words: "Please select your name" with a box underneath.
- Click on the down arrow, (located on the right side of the box), and all Philo members names will appear in an alphabetized list.

- Scroll down to your name.
- Click on your name.
- Your name now appears written in the box. (If a different name other than your name appears in the box then reselect the correct name. Your name is your password for you to drop or add your name to a committee. Once your correct name appears, then proceed to step 8.)
- Click on the box that says "Next". The new page will say "Welcome <u>(with your name)</u> and shows all committees.)
  - Please add and/or delete your name from committee memberships by clicking on the check boxes. (These check boxes are the outlined boxes located in the "drop me" or "add me" columns where changes can be made.
  - You then can "ADD" your name to a committee (if there is an opening) by clicking on the outlined box in the "add me" column. This change will not be visible until Step #9 when you "Update" your changes.
  - If you change your mind you can "DROP" your name from a committee by clicking on the outlined box in the "drop me" column. This change will not be visible until Step #9 when you "Update" your changes.
  - You can sign up for another committee at this time if you wish and / or a hostess in a select month. (Note: Signing up for hostess does not satisfy the requirement for your one committee participation for Philo membership.)
  - If an opening is not currently available, you can sign up for another committee and wait to see if an opening becomes available in the committee you want to sign up for later.
  - Philo's membership requirements only require that you sign up for one committee, however you may sign up for more committees if you wish and there is room.
- After adding and/or dropping your name on committees, scroll all the way to the bottom of the page and click the <u>"UPDATE</u>" button. This will update your selections and show the list of committees again. A summary of your changes will appear at the top of the page in a pink highlighted area. This summary will tell you if you added to or dropped from as a member/Chair/ or Co-chair and which committee. You can then revisit the committees you dropped from or added your name to and verify that your name is removed or added to a committee and that what you selected is what you want.

## YOUR CHANGES WILL NOT BE SAVED UNTIL YOU CLICK ON THE "UPDATE" BUTTON.

- If you need to make additional changes, then repeat step 8.
- If you are satisfied with your changes, then click on the <u>"NEXT"</u> BUTTON TO FINALIZE YOUR SELECTION. The "Next" button is located at the bottom of the page.

• A new page will appear and say, "Any previous changes have been saved. Thank you for updating your Philo Committee Participation."

Please disregard the area highlighted in pink that says: No drops made. No adds made.

You have completed the Philo Committee Signup for 2016-2017. Close the signup window/tab, and close the Members Only window/tab.
