from the Alternatives to Violence (ATV) committee!

Thank you to those who brought items for ATV to the last Philo meeting or dropped things off on my porch. Everything has been delivered. The ATV office is so grateful for the items and the ongoing support from the Philo women. We will collect items again at our March 13 meeting so if you forgot to bring your items the last time you'll see the list repeated below.

There are always needs at both the Transition House and the Safe House. You might be wondering how ATV meets some of the other needs of service recipients. There is a private group that provides funding for things that may not be covered under grants or other funding sources. This additional private funding covers residents of the Safe House as well as non-residents that are seen in the outreach office. For example, when a non-resident and her children need bus tickets to move out of the area for safety reasons, ATV submits a request to the private group. Once approved, the tickets are purchased and the family is on their way to safety!

ATV Needs:

- full size face wash and moisturizer
- mascara (brown, black)
- gift cards for bras (a woman may come in with no undergarments. The resident purchases a bra and underwear in their size and gives the receipt to case manager)
- small plastic storage containers
- cups
- water glasses
- water bottles
- towels
- full size toiletries (lotions, shampoo, conditioner, body wash)
- kids toiletries like (shampoo, lotion, powder)
- baby monitors
- hair ties
- samples from stores or hotels
