Blood Drive Committee

On April 19th we had another successful blood drive. We had 89 community members come to our drive and from that Bonfils was able to collect 78



units of blood. Thank you to our members who donated time by working a shift, bringing food, and to those who donated blood.

Our next drive is June 21st and we still have some slots open to work a shift or to bring food. Please call Deb Fillion (667-0326) if you would like to help out.

If you were at the April meeting, you heard that next year we will be changing from Bonfils Blood



Center to the Garth Englund Blood Center (Poudre Valley Health) for our blood drives. This change comes after some concern that our donors' blood was not being kept for local use thus causing

our area hospitals to buy back blood from Bonfils. The truth is that today our area hospitals rarely need to buy back blood from Bonfils but as Medical Center of the Rockies (MCR) continues to grow the need for blood will be greater. There are two blood donor centers that service Loveland community hospitals; NCMC Blood Donor Center (Banner Health McKee) and Garth Englund Blood Center (Poudre Valley). Each center was contacted and interviewed to compare what service they currently provide our community and what they could provide in comparison to Bonfils. NCMC Blood Donor Center does not have the resources to support our current drive of collecting 90-100 units of blood in one day. They would need to break it into two days. The Garth Englund Blood Center can support our current drive donations in one day at the current site of First United Methodist church. They also will provide the publicity flyers prior to the drive and juice, water and snacks. The logistics of scheduling donors can probably be done by Poudre Valley Hospital volunteers. They will honor any previous donations to Bonfils as part of their recognition

program. Given this good match the Board approved the change at their March board meeting.

We have had a long standing relationship with Bonfils that has made our drives the fourth largest in the state and we will miss working with their competent staff, but we are also looking forward to working with Garth Englund Blood Center as we help our community grow and prosper. This change will take place under the chairmanship of Heather Morrison and Stephanie Bradley. The start up will have some challenges and as in the past I know our Philo sisters will step up and help make this a smooth transition.
