To support the annual Philo Christmas food basket program, our canned food drive will be held at the First United Methodist Church, 533 N. Grant (Coy Hall) on Friday, December 3rd and Saturday, December 4th.

Last year we provided food for approximately 280 baskets - a Christmas meal and a little bit more. We also donated 8,667 pounds of canned and dried food to the House of Neighborly Service. At an average of 11/4 pounds per meal per person, we have helped many people in their time of need. This year, 100% of all remaining food will again go to HNS.

One of the great satisfactions in life is helping others. Thanks to all our Philo members who will help us make this a reality.
