Canned Food Drive

Philo's oldest tradition is the delivery of food baskets to the needy during the holidays. An integral part of this program is the canned food drive. Philo coordinates the drive with schools in the Thompson R2-J



School District during the two weeks following Thanksgiving. At the end of the drive, our members and volunteers pick up the food, sort it with the help of Bill Reed Middle School students, and have a pick-up day for folks who are going to deliver food baskets. Two other Philo committees are responsible for "food basket delivery" or "food basket donor-recipient-matching".

To do this, WE NEED EVERYONE'S HELP for our annual CANNED FOOD DRIVE. How can you help? You can sign up at our October and November general meetings.

- 1. Drive pickups or large vans (your vehicles) to move canned food from participating Loveland schools to First United Methodist Church.
- 2. Sort and organize food at the church (Coy Hall).
- 3. Help distribute canned goods to the food basket donors.
- 4. Pack up leftovers for collection by Larimer County Food Bank.

This is a HUGE job, but very rewarding. Committee chairs have contacted over 25 Loveland area schools – most are participating in the drive and welcome helping Philo with this important project. It is a lot of fun and a great service to the community. Last year we picked up, sorted, and boxed tons of food. Thanks in advance for your participation!


