Philo coordinates the drive with the schools in Thompson R2-J School district during the month of November. At the end of the drive, our members and volunteers pick up the food, sort it with the help of Bill Reed Middle School students and have a "shopping" day for the folks who need to fill food baskets. There are two other Philo committees who are responsible for "food Basket delivery" and "food basket donor-recipient-matching". To do this, we need EVERYONE'S help for our annual Canned Food Drive. How can you help? You can sign up at our October and November general meetings.



Here is a list of jobs we need volunteers for:

1. Drive pick-ups or vans to move canned goods from participating schools to the First United Methodist Church.
2. Sort and organize food at the church.
3. Pack-up leftovers cans for collection to the House of Neighborly Service.
4. Donations of snacks for the volunteers

This is a HUGE job, but it is very rewarding. Last year we had over 20 schools participate in the drive and we donated over 8,600 pounds to the House of Neighborly Service after all the baskets had been filled. We look forward to another great drive. Thanks in advance for your participation!
