
Attendance at five (5) regularly scheduled meetings is required. The Christmas and Spring Appreciation Socials may be counted in that


Woody Allen said "90% of life is just showing up." I think we do much better than that - we show up, get the job done and look fabulous while doing it!

Winter Coat and Magazine Donations:


