Dear Philo sisters,

I have an inherited kidney disease. Many members of my family died in their 50's, and my mother lost her kidney and went on dialysis in her 50's. It has finally caught up with me at age 74. I am currently in stage four renal failure. I made it longer than anyone in my family so far. I have met with the transplant team at University Hospital in Denver, passed the required tests, and have been officially placed on the transplant list. I will continue to be on the national list, but the wait is 3-5 years. They, therefore are suggesting that I seek out a live donor. If you, or anyone you know, is interested in donating a kidney and saving a life, please contact me at 667-7841 OR email me at pmack57@aol.com. I will then turn it over to their living donor coordinator, Neshiyquah Nash. Due to patient/donor confidentiality, she will then take over. Our insurance covers all donor costs.
