For the last two years I have been studying the Philo scrapbooks, taking notes on traditional and special events, and compiling a list of every woman who appeared in a Philo yearbook. Now I need help to fill in some gaps. I would be happy to receive any loans or donations.

My goal is to preserve information from the scrapbooks on the Philo web page for all members to share. As we go forward we hope to create digital scrapbooks rather than add to the 13 huge volumes we now store and pass along from Historian to Historian.

New Fundraising Opportunity

We have a new fundraising opportunity, thanks to the King Soopers Neighborhood Rewards Program.

How does the program work?

- Purchase a reloadable gift card for \$10. You will receive a card with \$10 on it to be used at King Soopers.
- Take it to the customer service desk or reload it before you buy your groceries right at the checkout stand. Each time you shop reload your card. Or reload once a month. You can use cash, checks, or a charge card to reload up to \$500 at a time. The gift card must be reloaded in a separate transaction prior to your groceries being scanned.
- Cards can be used to purchase anything at King Soopers except services.
 - CAN BE USED FOR: Groceries, prescriptions, gas
 - EXEMPT SERVICES: Western Union money orders, Ticket Master, postage stamps, lottery tickets or other gift cards.
- To receive 5% cash back from King Soopers, we must reload \$5,000 in a four-week cycle. This should be pretty easy to do, since we all buy groceries. (If we don't reach \$5,000 in a single four week cycle the funds are rolled into the next four week cycle.)
- You can buy as many cards as you like. Anyone who shops at King Soopers is a potential customer (relatives, neighbors, friends, co-workers, even total strangers). The cards are accepted at MOST Kroger affiliated stores throughout the US. (Kroger, City Market, Fred Meyer, etc.)
- You can have more than one of these cards. If you are already helping another group fundraise you can have a card from as many groups as you like.
- The cards will be marked so you'll know it is your Philo fundraising card.

The money will go into the Philo account, so we are all working together on this.

We will have 20 cards available at the October meeting. We will purchase more once those are sold (we have to pre-purchase these, and don't want to buy more than we need). The cards CANNOT be purchased at King Soopers; they have to be purchased through Philo to have the funds go to Philo.
