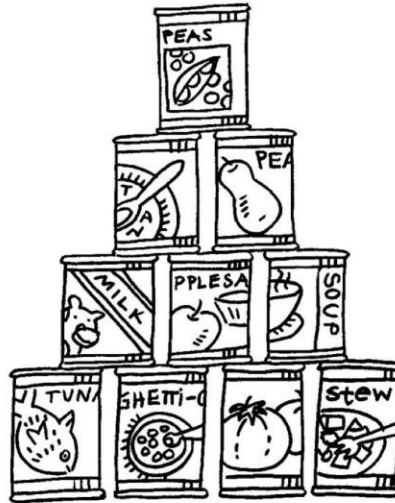
### Furniture and Household Item
