Mine was busy as usual. Fortunately, I was still able to fit in some quality time with several of my Philo sisters to prepare for this upcoming year.

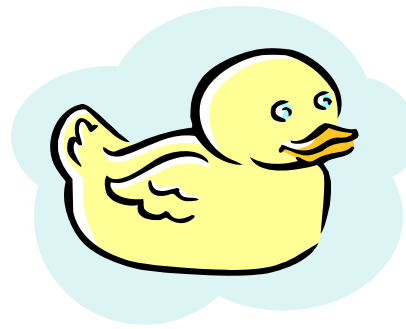
In the late summer the board met at my house with many of the new chairs and past year chairs. I think we had a great brainstorming session and just some great socializing in general.
