The charts at the left show the attendance from September through May and the percentage of attendance. As you can see October was the best attended month for active members and December was the best month for our honoraries.




As new technologies become part of our every day lives, it is important for Philo to keep up with the times. So, thanks to Kay Robinson's husband,
